



## A Visual Guide to Full Paper Upload and Abstract / Paper Revision

Only the corresponding author may make revisions and corrections via "[My Submission](#)" link. The corresponding author may:

- ❑ Revise the Abstract Title and Abstract (slight adaptation is permitted), authors' and/or presenters' names.
- ❑ Upload the Full Paper or a revised version of it (by simultaneously deleting any previously submitted version).

In order to view/revise your submitted abstract/paper:

1. Sign-in at [UACE2019](#) using your credentials.
2. Navigate to Authors Area > My Submissions

Under *My Submissions* you will see a list with your submitted abstract(s). Make a note of the abstract(s) ID(s). You will need this information during the Conference Registration process.

3. Click on the Abstract's title to view/revise the abstract/paper.

If you have previously uploaded a full paper, it will appear under the “Upload” button. Please mark it for deletion (by ticking the little box next to it). In this way, we eliminate the possibility of accidentally using the wrong paper version in the Proceedings.
